 - This includes mounting, balancing, new valve stem, tire disposal and sales tax
 - Tire replacement must be with a new tire of like kind, quality and cost

Excludes cosmetic damage.

To be eligible for coverage, a covered vehicle tire must have a minimum of 3/32" of tread remaining at time of damage.
